

**AMENDED ORDINANCE NO. 2020-18**  
**TOWN OF MILTON**  
**AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING SCHLAWIN ROAD**  
**AS A HEAVY TRAFFIC ROUTE**

**WHEREAS**, Wis. Stat. §349.17 authorizes the Town to designate any street or highway as a heavy traffic route and designate the type and character of vehicles which may be operated thereon; and

**WHEREAS**, the Town Board believes it expedient and necessary to designate Schlawin Road as a heavy traffic route and designate the type and character of vehicles which may be operated thereon;

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Town Board of the Town of Milton, Buffalo County, Wisconsin, does hereby ordain as follows:

- Section 1. Schlawin Road is hereby designated a Heavy Traffic Route pursuant to Wis. Stat. §349.17.
- Section 2. No thru traffic shall be permitted on Schlawin Road with respect to any vehicle with a licensed gross weight in excess of ~~7,200 pounds~~ 4 tons. Schlawin Road shall be so posted.
- Section 3. The restrictions imposed by this Ordinance do not prohibit heavy traffic from using Schlawin Road for the purpose of obtaining orders or supplies or moving or delivery of supplies or commodities to or from any place of business or residence which has an entrance on the Highway.
- Section 4. The term "heavy traffic" has the definition as set forth in Wis. Stat. §349.17(2), except that the gross weight limitation shall be ~~7,200 pounds~~ 4 tons.
- Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect upon passage and posting.
